

Public Abstract

Deliverable D6.8 Data Reporting N1



In this first knowledge management data reporting exercise, the partners were asked to report to the data providers their data for the period 1st September 2015 to 31 December 2015, as per the two research objects that were defined:

1/ HEALTHCODE_Diagnosis_μchp. HEALTH-CODE data related to combined heat and power (CHP) applications (residential, μ-CHP);

2/ HEALTHCODE_Diagnosis_Backup. HEALTH-CODE data related to back-up-power applications.

For each of the research objects, two sets of parameters were defined before the first data reporting exercise was launched:

1/- The **first** set of parameters (1 to 17) deal with the “**descriptive parameters**”: they are more or less project-specific and are unlikely to change in time, essentially describing the “scene” for which the project partners are reporting.

2/- The **second** set of parameters requested (1 to 34) consists of “**operational parameters**”, essentially referring to the reporting exercise.

For all parameters the partners were asked to provide a **value** and a **comment** that could help to make an interpretation of the data. **For each parameter**, the partners could specify whether they wanted the FCH JU to treat it as public or confidential.

For this first data reporting exercise, the TEMONAS platform was used.
